A native of Denmark, Eric Bøgh Christensen began his career in the Far East in 1970, when he joined the East Asiatic Company in Hong Kong. During the next 20 years he served in a variety of managerial positions including an eight-year appointment to the Beijing office.

In 1983 he was appointed Group Managing Director with overall responsibility for all EAC's trading, shipping and industrial activities in Hong Kong and China.

In 1990, Mr. Christensen was transferred to EAC's head office in Copenhagen as Deputy General Manager responsible for EAC Shipping, and in 1994 he became Group Executive Vice President.

He returned to the Far East in June 1997 when he became Managing Director and Chief Executive of Modern Terminals Limited. MTL is Hong Kong's longest-established container port operator, and commands a 30% market share in the World's busiest container port, Hong Kong.
