Root Cause– What Makes Administrative Tasks a Burden



- Repetitive task of Information sharing
 - Almost same paper work is shared with different stakeholders in terms of port forms, reports, documents etc.
 - Different stakeholders have varying degree of completed information, resulting in repeated updates
- Lack of centralized storage for quick information access,
- Search for Information across mammoth manuals, documents, reports
- Maintain, Display and Print record
- Lack of Manpower to do specific administrative tasks



Scenario with other Industries and Solutions Adopted



Similar Industries like aviation, tourism, hospitality experienced excessive paperwork since last two decades.

However they were quick to adopt solutions like

- Outsourcing, offshoring of Non Core activities like
 - data entry,
 - record keeping
 - Reporting, Analytics, MIS etc.
- Adoption of technology based solutions like Digitization and Integrated workflows for core activities
- Accessing Information using cloud based storage
- Adopting SaaS, Spatial Data Management





Possible Solutions – What Maritime Industry can Adopt



- Outsourcing, Offshoring
 - Shore based teams can prepare and keep all the required documents ready easily applicable for arrival departure paper work, planning of work rest hours etc.
 - Generating of MIS reports
- Digitization and adopting Document Management, Knowledge Management Systems for
 - Enabling workflows for reporting between Ship & shore
 - Enabling access of same information and better search through a centralized repository
- Spatial Data Management for Tracking vessels, Information sharing with different stakeholders owners,

Flag State, Port State, Commercial bodies






Knowledge Manager – Centralized Repository Tree Structure with Virtual Spaces








Audit System - Planning



- Application that plans for audits based on anniversary dates.
- Allows flexibility to view planned line items and prioritize depending upon their stage overdue, due etc.
- Assign/Reassign an auditor depending upon his availability, location



- Ability to notify and remind auditors before certain days automatically
- Ability import database in excel




