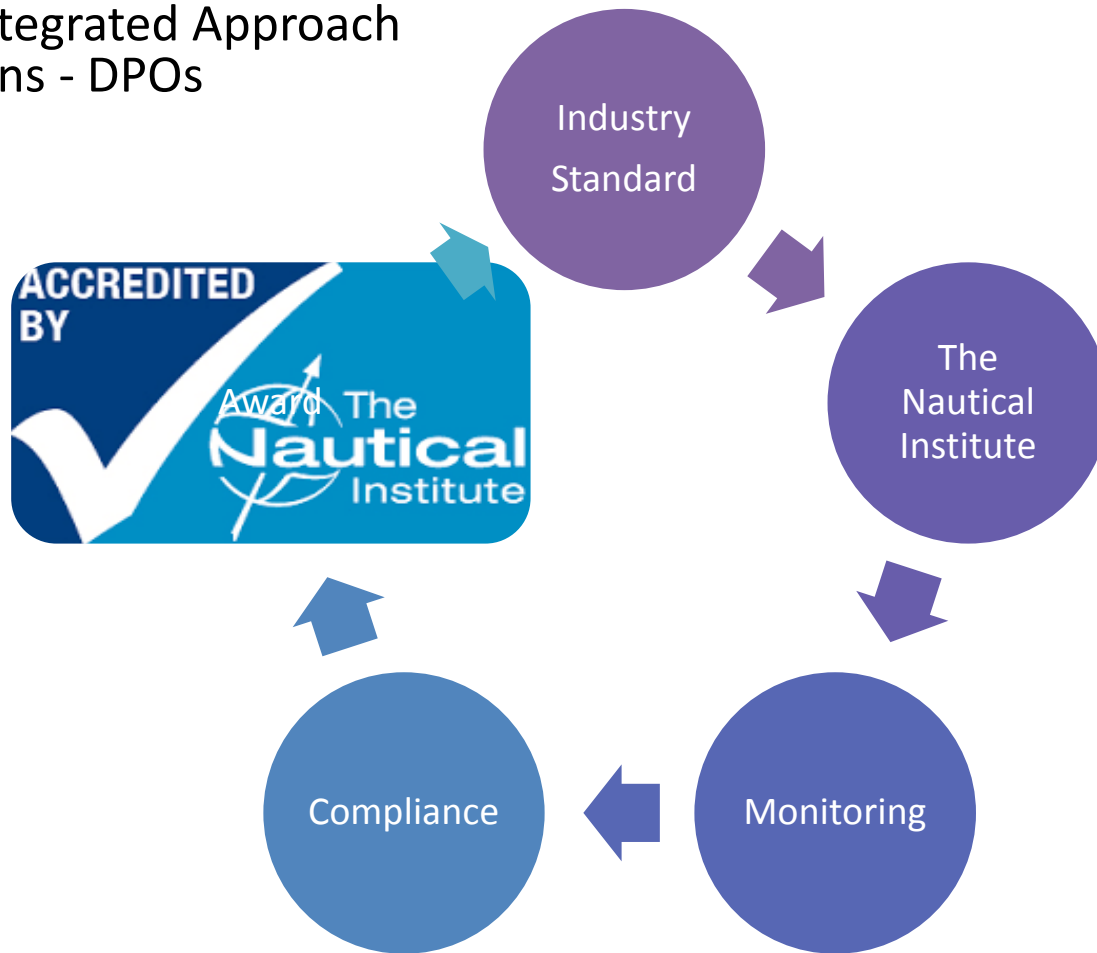

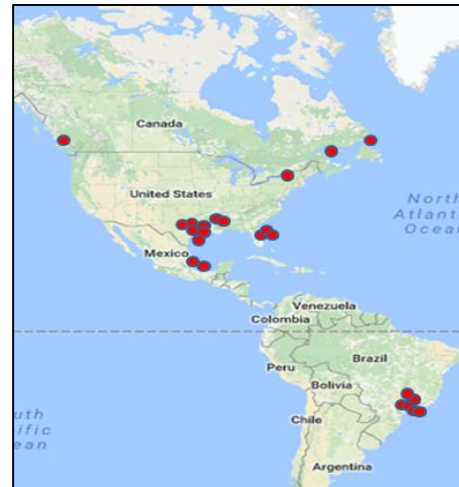

A Global Solution: Accessibility

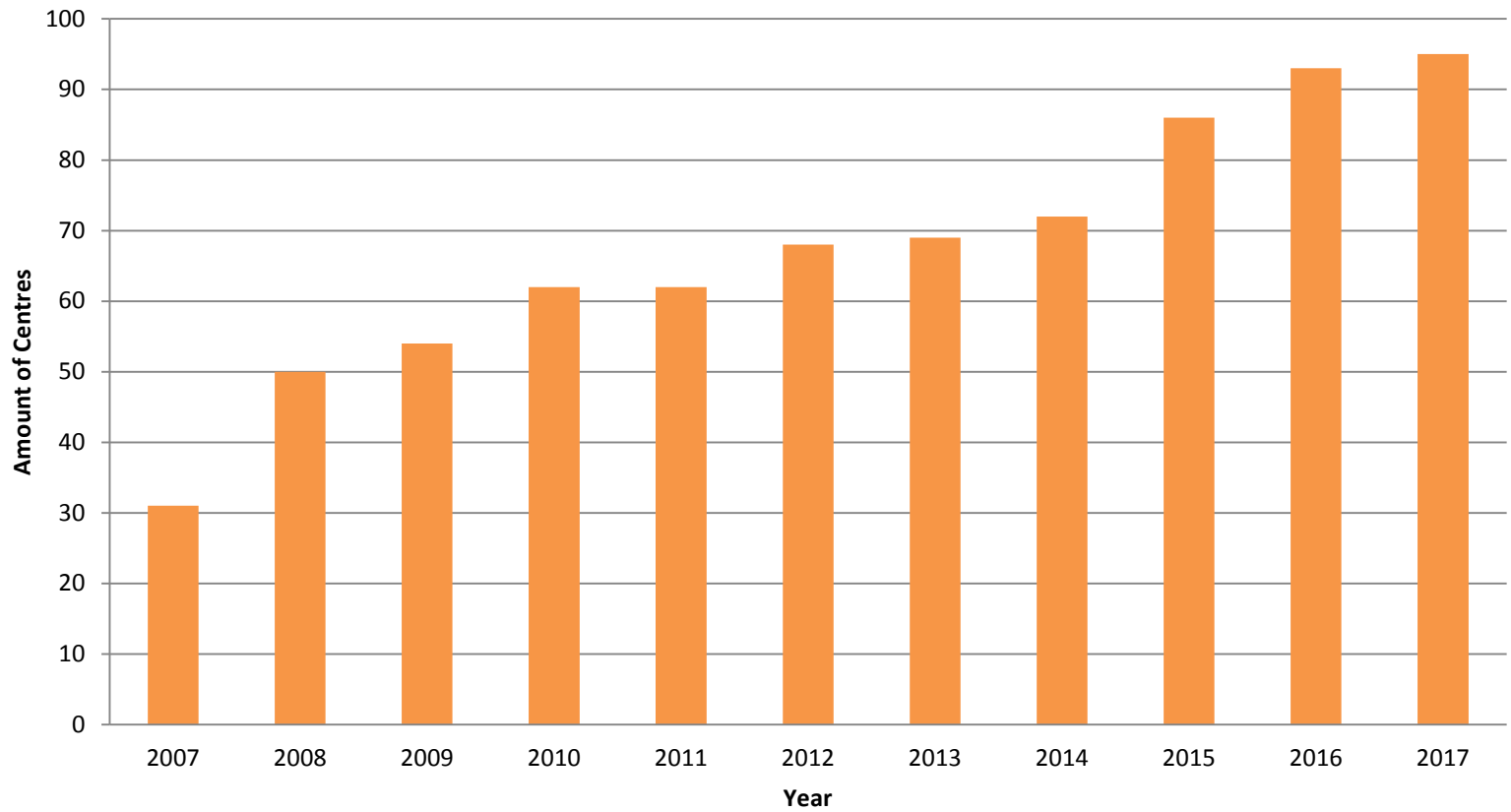
Training Centres

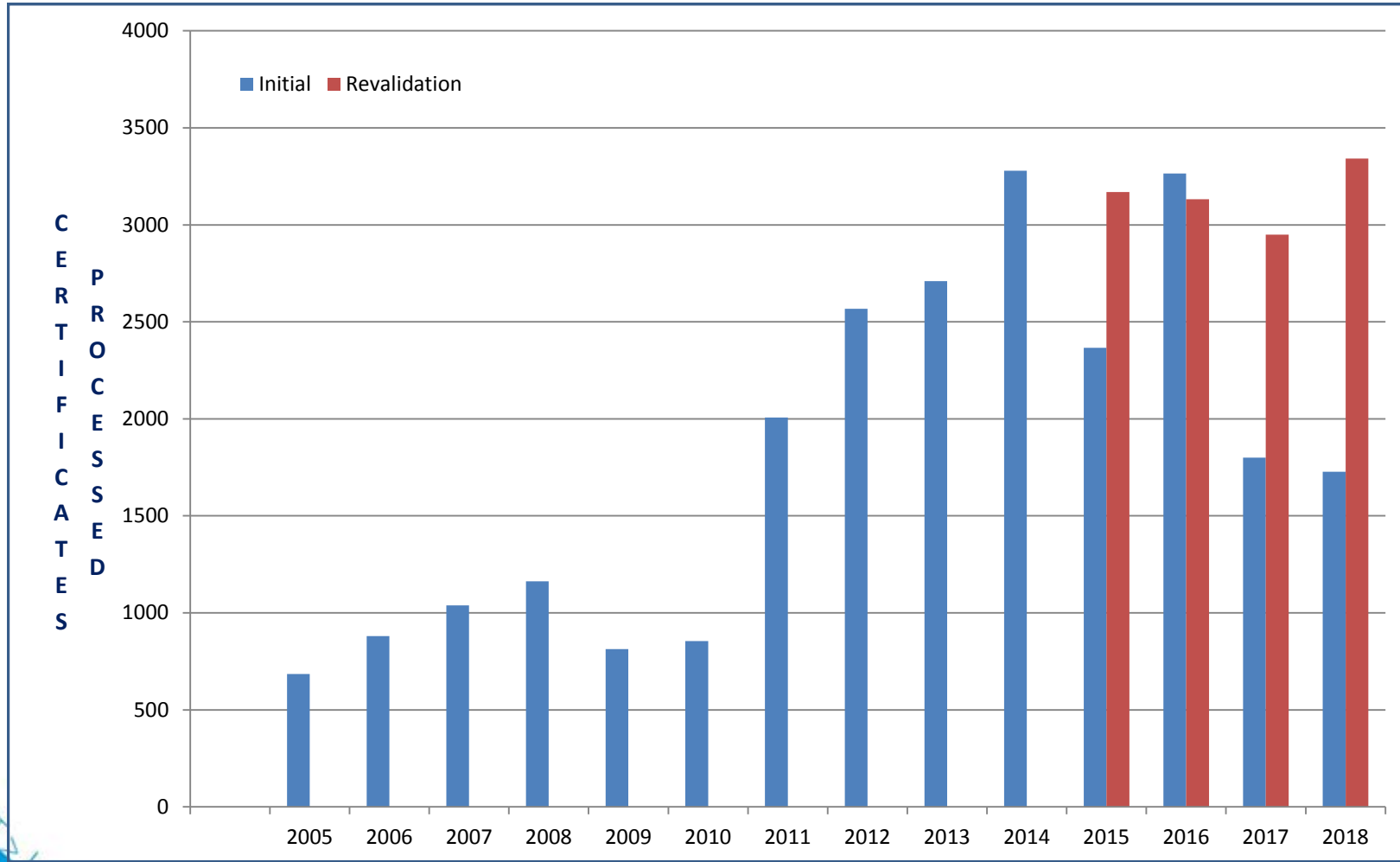

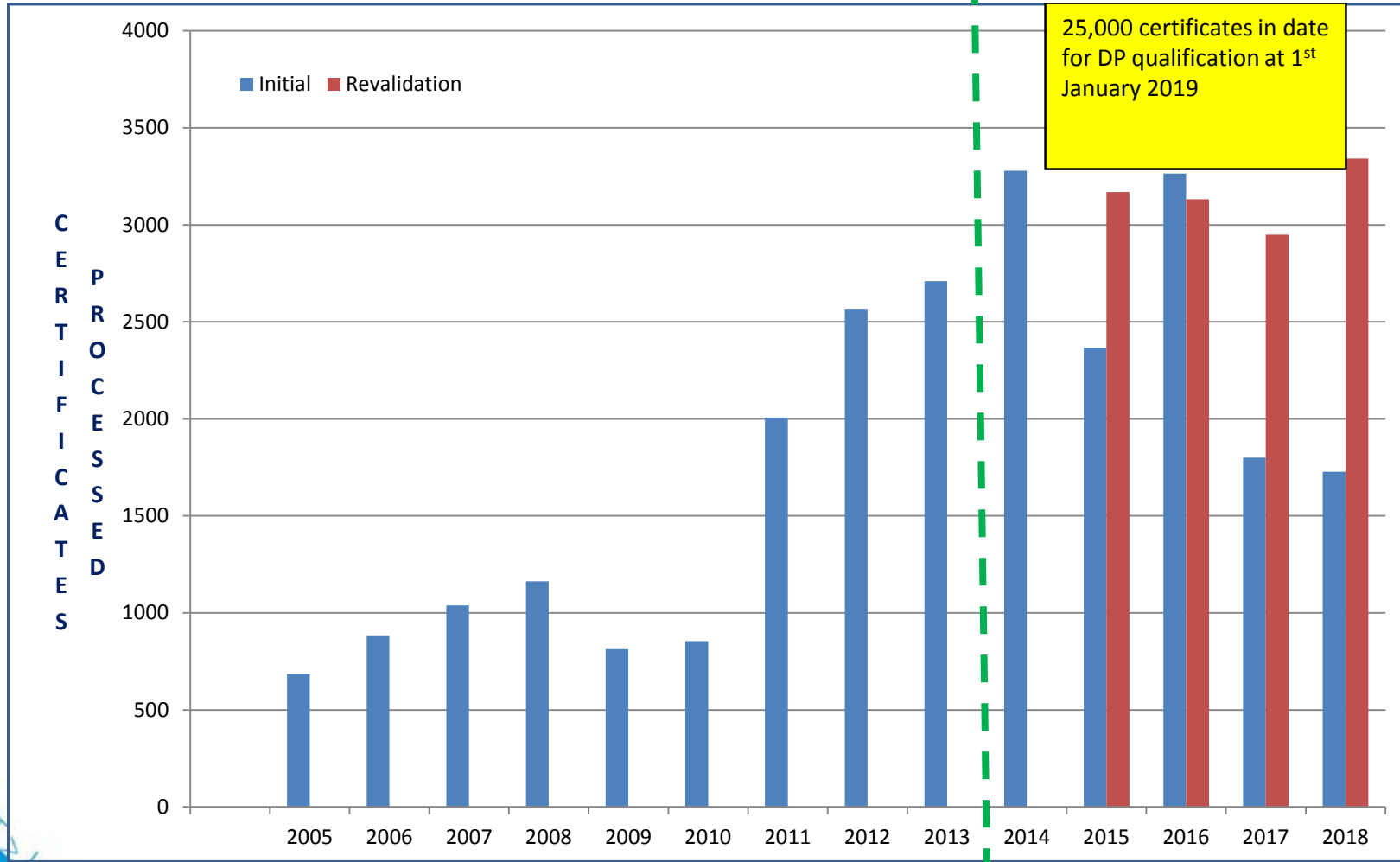

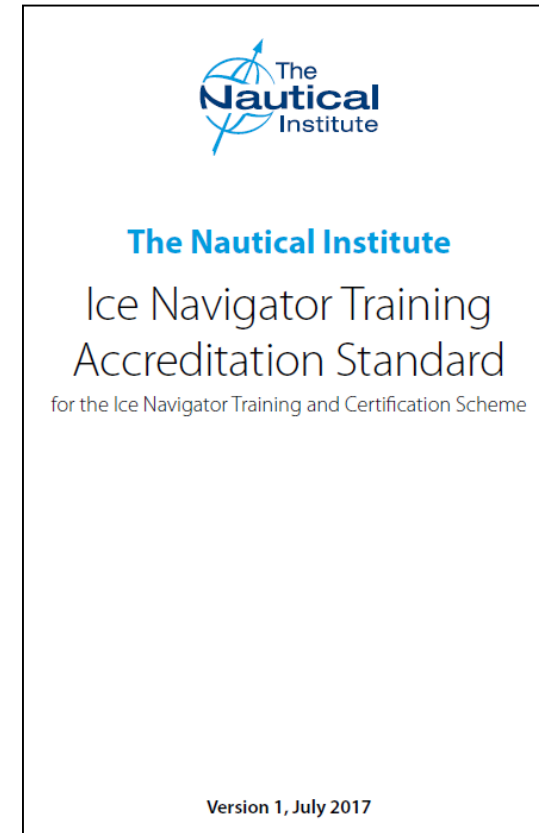

- Launched July 2017

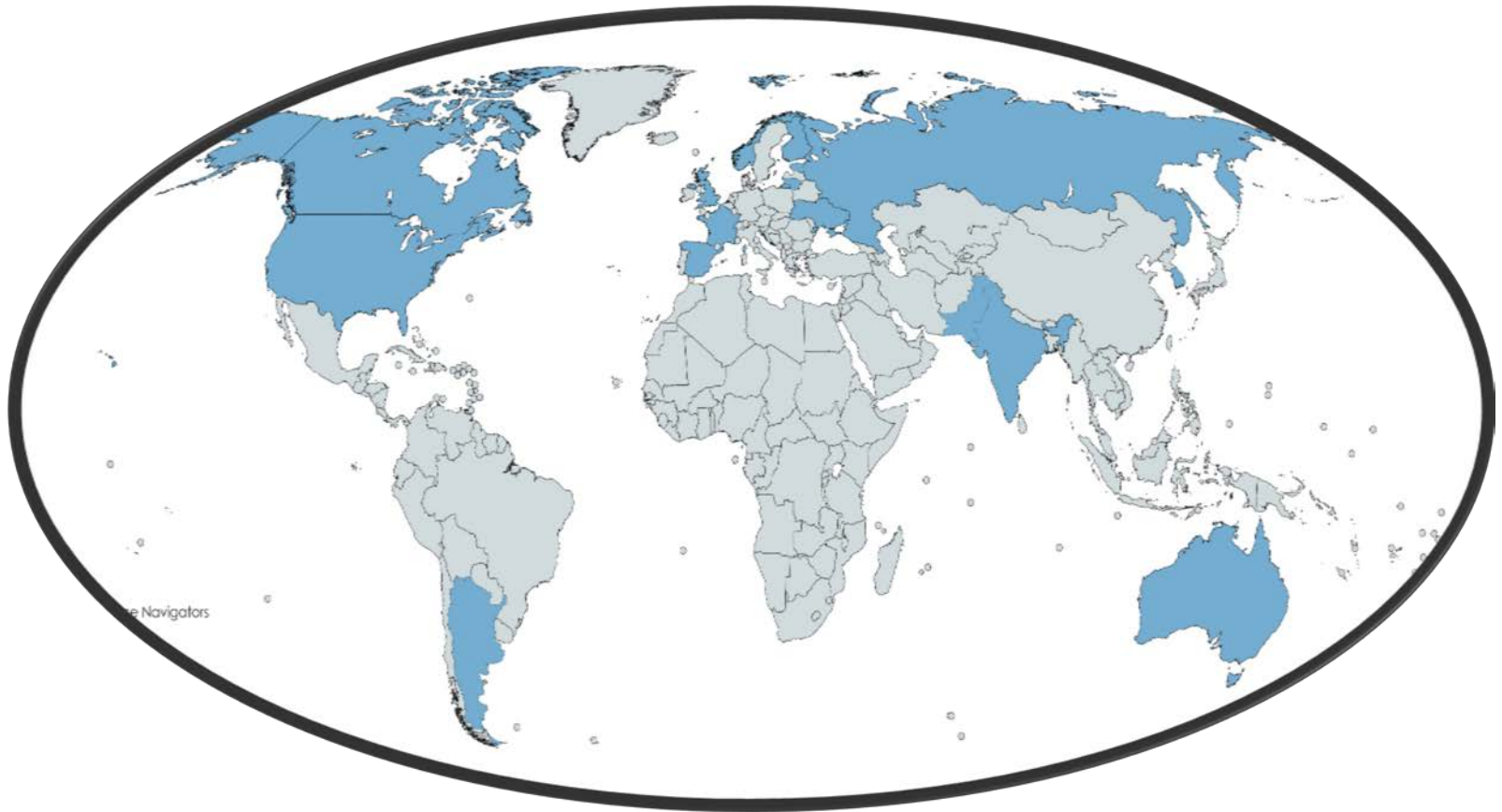


Where are we now?

- Almost no Level 1 applications

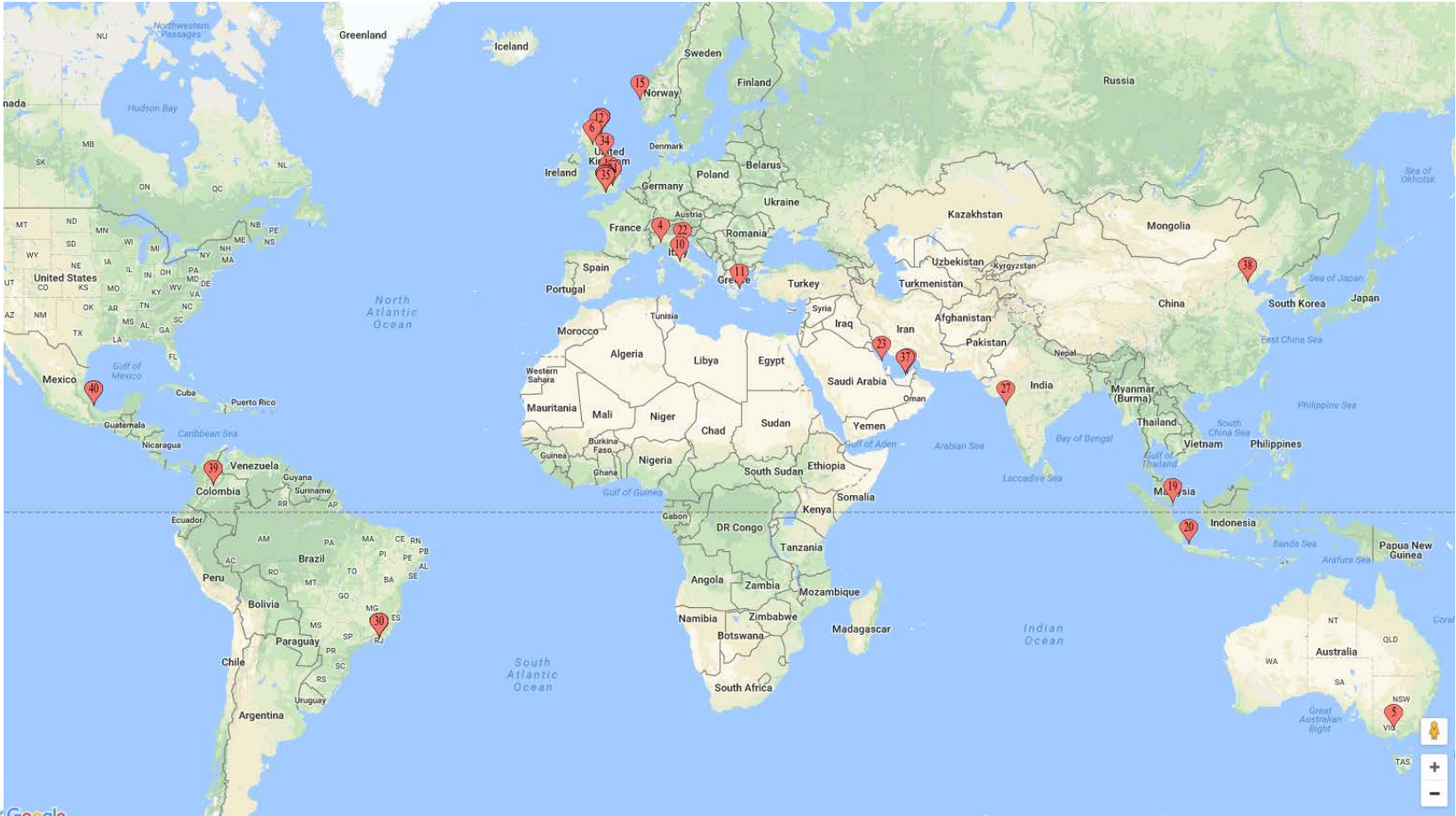
